Philanthropy part of Biles' routine

Last week was a whirlwind week for Simone Biles.

With her Gold Over America Tour on a one-week break, Biles unveiled a partnership with Barefoot wine and was named the world's most marketable athlete of the year by SportsPro. She attended the Los Angeles premiere of the second part of her Netflix docuseries "Simone Biles: Rising." And on Thursday night, she donated \$50,000 at a gala for Friends of Children, a nonprofit that provides mentors for kids facing adversity — including those in the foster care system, as Biles once was.

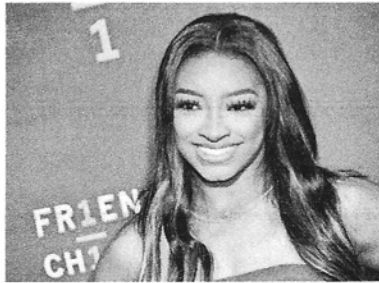
"It's so important to me because I can see myself in these kids and what they go through and what they grow through," Biles told USA TODAY Sports. "Sometimes the statistics can be against you, but having someone like me advocate for these kids, and knowing I went through some of the same similar situations that these kids have gone through and come out of it on top really inspires them."

During an interview last Thursday at a luxury hotel in Santa Monica, California, Biles spoke with USA TODAY Sports' visual journalist Sandy Hooper about her philanthropic work and a wide range of other topics.

• Simone Biles on supporting kids in foster care

Biles has been open about her experience with the foster care system. She has said she spent about three years in foster care before she was 6 years old, as her biological mother, Shannon, struggled with drugs and alcohol.

"Growing up in foster (care), the statistics are just against you and it is what it is," she said. "But coming out on top of that, rising above — obviously I had my family to help, but I am who I am today because of foster care. And so I want to

kids to also cherish and remember that and that you can do anything. It doesn't matter."

Biles said she's felt more strongly about the importance of speaking out about her past as she's gotten older. She's also tried to be available for questions from kids in foster care, she said, to act as a resource and inspiration.

"Most of the time it's all silly questions because they're so young and they're curious," she said when asked about her interactions with the kids. "How old are you? How tall are you? Do you have a boyfriend? ... It usually doesn't get too serious with the kids, except for the older ones. They want to know why I did it, what I'm passionate about, stuff like that. But they are hilarious. I love them."

• Simone Biles on her Netflix docuseries

"Simone Biles: Rising" is a four-episode docuseries covering her return to competition and journey to the 2024 Paris Olympics. It was released in two parts, with the first two episodes debuting before the Games and the final two

episodes hitting Netflix last Friday.

Biles said the pre-Olympic release of the docuseries didn't bring any pressure.

"I actually got to see the episodes beforehand and I talked with my therapist about it," she said. "And yes, the timing was a little bit risky, but I knew that I had already done all the work mentally that I was OK that it came out at the time that it did."

Biles also filmed a docuseries ahead of the Tokyo Olympics. She said the process for "Simone Biles: Rising" was significantly easier, without the constraints of the COVID-19 pandemic, and it helped having the same director, Katie Walsh.

"The team that I've worked with for so many years, I feel really comfortable with them. So it was really a breeze," Biles said.

• Simone Biles on Jordan Chiles' appeal

In an unusual twist, Biles' Netflix docuseries also led to footage that could help her teammate, Jordan Chiles, retain her bronze medal on floor exer-

cise from the Paris Games.

Chiles recently filed an appeal with the highest court in Switzerland in hopes of resolving a dispute about whether the scoring inquiry she filed was submitted past the 60-second deadline. After the Court of Arbitration for Sport ruled that it was submitted late, footage from the documentary appears to show that the inquiry was on time, giving Chiles a route for an appeal.

When asked about her reaction when she found out that the footage from her documentary could help Chiles, Biles demurred.

"This is not my topic to speak about, but we are going to support Jordan as much as we can and love her and uplift her because it's a tough situation," she said.

• Simone Biles on her husband's Olympic interest

With the Olympics behind her, Biles said she is excited to have more time to pursue other interests — and cheer on her husband, Jonathan Owens, who is a safety for the Chicago Bears.

Biles has not said whether she intends to compete at the next Summer Olympics, in Los Angeles in 2028, though it's now possible that her husband could be there. Flag football will be on the Olympic sports program in 2028 for the first time, and there are ongoing discussions about whether NFL players could or should compete for Team USA.

"I think it'd be very interesting. I think it'd be a lot of fun," Biles said when asked about her husband and his Bears teammates possibly competing in 2028. "I know that my husband and his teammates have talked a lot about it, if they're going to do it. But it's a lot of sacrifice. It's in the summer, right when they start training camp, so I know it'd be really tough on their body just because of how long their season is. But they're very excited about it, and they're excited. So we'll see."

Shiffrin OK talking about records now

Mikaela Shiffrin has decided to lean into the hype.

Talking about records and victories has always made the two-time Olympic champion uncomfortable. Which is somewhat problematic, given she has a lot of both.

As she closes in on her 100th World Cup victory, though, Shiffrin is taking a different view of it.

She loves her sport, and she wants others to love it, too. If she, and her records specifically, are the gateway to that, bring it on.

"Bringing energy to the sport is never a bad thing," Shiffrin said last week, three days before she began the season with a pair of giant slalom races in Soelden, Austria.

"I'm energized right now by people bringing up 100," she added. "I think it's incredible that people are still following along on this journey and are excited about it. I would say that's an incredible positive."

There aren't enough superlatives to describe what Shiffrin has done in Alpine skiing. Ingemar Stenmark's 86 World Cup victories was a mark once considered untouchable and she's shattered it, beginning this season with 97. Her five overall titles trail only Marcel Hirscher (eight) and Annemarie Moser-Pröell (six).

Shiffrin is tied with Stenmark and Lindsey Vonn for most season titles in a single discipline, with eight.

And her 60 World Cup slalom wins are the most by any skier in a single discipline.

Her 17 wins in the 2018-19 season are the most by any skier, male or female, and she's also the first to win a race in six different disciplines.

Shall I keep going?

But the records are not what drive Shiffrin. Never have.

Neither do the wins, exactly. She is humble by nature, incapable of seeing herself in the same way as other elite athletes.

Mostly, though, she's a nerd about the process, taking joy in finding some way to get a little better, a little bit faster every time she puts on a pair of skis. The wins are simply a byproduct of that.

And those wins, they're more about their context than a place on a podium or another piece of hardware. Take Shiffrin's 87th win, the one in March 2023 that broke Stenmark's record. Yes, she's well aware of its historic significance. But its personal significance was because her brother and sister-in-law, who she rarely gets to see during the ski season, flew in to surprise her. They joined Shiffrin's mother, Eileen, who is also one of her coaches, in the finish area.

"My family was there," Shiffrin said. "Those kind of key things, they become core memories because of what surrounds it, not because of the record itself."

Shiffrin has tried to explain all this a

million times, in a million different ways. But we're a results-driven society, and the numbers she's put up are impossible to ignore or downplay.

If she's going to get asked about another record or a win, Shiffrin's decided she can at least put that spotlight to good use. Last week she announced a partnership with Share Winter, a foundation that brings winter sports to kids and communities that historically have not had access to them.

In addition to talking about Share Winter, Shiffrin is planning to tie-in with the foundation around her 100th World Cup win and other milestones.

"One of the main goals of my career is

not just to inspire people who are already accessing winter sports and already doing them, but to help share that passion and access to people beyond. Especially youth and kids out there that otherwise wouldn't be able to do it," she said.

"I think it's just such a beautiful goal and ... in this stage of my career, it places a different kind of meaning on it," Shiffrin added. "It changes my perspective on the whole record conversation. I'm seeing it as an opportunity more than, 'Oh (shoot), everyone's going to be asking me about the record and this and that.'"

"That's been my mentality for so long, trying to avoid those questions. I'm actually excited now because it's just such an incredible opportunity to bring more eyes, and ideally more passion, to the sport."

Shiffrin was 17 when she got her first World Cup victory, 18 when she won her first Olympic gold medal. Now 29, she knows she's closer to the end of her career than the beginning.

But that finish line remains a ways away, and there's a lot more to be accomplished before she crosses it.

Starting with that 100th World Cup win, which could come as early as next month.

Maybe even at the World Cup stop at Shiffrin's beloved Killington.

"I feel almost less pressure about it because I just think it's exciting people want to be excited for it. So let's go for it," she said.

"Try to have fun with it, I guess." And do some good while she's at it.
