# High Bahlin' ahead of softball super regionals

One of the most memorable regional weekends in NCAA softball tournament history ended fittingly.

As the clock was preparing to strike midnight May 18, with two on, two out and the score tied against Stanford, Oregon's Dez Patmon launched the first pitch she saw into the cool Pacific Northwest night. As soon as she hit it, Patmon and every other Duck on the pond knew it was gone. Sure enough, it sailed over the left-field wall.

A walk-off homer to punctuate regionals. Perfect.

But before the softball world turns its attention to super regionals May 22 — by this time next week, we'll know the Eight for Oklahoma City, the teams coming to town for the Women's College World Series — let's pause and relish the regionals for a moment. There was drama. There was excellence. There was history.

It was three days of grand softball.

Now, was it the greatest regional weekend of them all? If you want to base that on the number of teams that went on the road and upset a nationally seeded host to win, you'd have a good argument. Four national seeds were upended, but that's only the second most in the past decade. And since the current regional-to-super-regional format began in 2005, four or more road teams have won regionals six other times.

Then again, this year was special. For starters, you had a national seed not even survive to the third day of regionals. No. 10 LSU was bounced from its own regional May 17.

But of course, the biggest drama of these regionals was the ouster of top-seeded Texas A&M. Since this current format was adopted, the No. 1 seed has never failed to win its regional and advance to super.

The Aggies are the first, bounced by Liberty.

So, what should we take away from this first weekend of the NCAA tournament?

In honor of our Eight for OKC, here are eight things we learned:

## 1. Give me Liberty!

Not since James Madison and ace Otilci Alexander made the WCWS in 2021 has the field included a mid-major program, but Liberty is entirely capable of being the next.

The Flames went to Texas A&M and beat the Aggies in two out of three. Oh, the double-elimination regional isn't set up as a best-of-three format, but it just worked out that way.

Liberty beat A&M 8-5 in a winners' bracket game, then after losing 14-1 in

eight innings the next day, Liberty turned around and beat A&M 6-5 later that night. The Flames had every opportunity to go out. In that extra-inning loss, they squandered an early 6-0 lead, rallied to send it to extras with four runs in the bottom of the seventh inning, only to give up three in the top of the eighth and lose. Talk about a deflating situation.

But ace Elena Escobar threw 298 pitches in three games against the Aggies before Liberty coach Dot Richardson made the move of the tournament, pulling Escobar for Kaylan Yoder, who hadn't thrown a pitch in the regional. She got the final five outs for the Flames.

And the Liberty offense? It was powered by senior slugger Rachel Roupe, who went 7-for-13 with three homers and nine RBIs against Texas A&M. Look out, Oregon.

## 2. S-E-C-I S-E-C-I S-E-C-I

The SEC was the talk of the tournament before it even started, securing seven of the top eight seeds and nine of the top 16.

Then 10th-seeded LSU was bounced, and top-seeded A&M went bye-bye. That couldn't help but knock down some of the conference bravado.

And yet heading into super regionals, the SEC is guaranteed three spots in the WCWS with all-SEC matchups between Oklahoma and Alabama, Florida and Georgia, and Arkansas and Ole Miss. Yes, unseeded Georgia and Ole Miss recaptured some of the oomph, knocking off No. 14 Duke and No. 13 Arizona, respectively.

So, the SEC could still have six of the eight teams in Oklahoma City.

## 3. Jordy Bahlin is bahlin'

Lots of eyes were on the Nebraska

as she led the Cornhuskers into the tournament a year after blowing out her knee. Bahlin and Co. looked like the team that would threaten LSU in the Baton Rouge regional, but Southeastern Louisiana took care of LSU and Nebraska took care of Southeastern Louisiana.

Even though the Bahli-Bayou Bengals matchup never materialized, she was impressive. She allowed just two hits and one earned run in 12 innings.

But as good as she was in the circle, she might've been better at the plate. She hit homers in each of her first four at-bats in the regional and finished 5-for-5 with six RBIs and nine runs scored.

## 4. Welcome to the WCWS party

The WCWS is guaranteed at least one newbie this year; Arkansas and Ole Miss will meet in the Fayetteville super regional, and neither program has been to the World Series.

But there could be as many as three newbies.

Liberty has never even advanced to a super regional, much less the WCWS, but after knocking off Texas A&M, doubt the Flames at your own risk.

Then, there's Texas Tech. The Red Raiders are only making their seventh NCAA tournament appearance, but with reigning national player of the year Nijaree Canady in the circle, would anyone be surprised to see her back in Oklahoma City? Familiar face, new team.

## 5. Seed the top 32 teams

As exciting as Liberty's regional triumph over Texas A&M was, the Flames shouldn't have even been assigned to the College Station Regional.

They are better than the 32nd-best

team in this tournament.

The selection committee is supposed to bracket by the S-curve, the best unseeded team is paired with the 16th seed, the next best unseeded team with the 15th, and on and on. Of course, conference foes aren't allowed in the same regional, much as they aren't allowed in the same first- and second-round pods in the basketball tournaments, so that creates some bracketing challenges. But without seeding to No. 32, the selection committee isn't on the hook about the regional pairings.

There needs to be more accountability for a more equitable bracket, especially as talent expands, coaching improves and parity increases.

## 6. Lonni Alameda is tough as nails

The Florida State coach is battling breast cancer and continues taking weekly treatments. Even though they have undoubtedly sapped her energy while taking the long, lush hair that used to spill below her signature ball cap, Alameda didn't miss the Seminoles' regional.

There's a line in the Florida State fight song that says, "So fight, fight, fight, fight for victory."

Alameda is doing just that.

## 7. Oklahoma gonna be hard to beat

Duh, right? The Sooners have won the past four national titles and six of the past nine.

But this is an almost totally rebuilt team — and yet no team was more impressive in regionals. The Sooners run-ruled their way to three victories and an undefeated weekend, playing the minimum of 15 innings and winning by a combined score of 31-3.

OU has won 16 consecutive regional games and 15 consecutive regionals.

We'll save the Sooners' super-regional winning streak for next week.

## 8. UCLA might be the sneakiest team left

How the Bruins might sneak up on anyone is almost unfathomable; no program has won more national titles than UCLA.

But with all the SEC-and-SEC-that talk this season, the Bruins have flown a bit under the radar. After run-ruling their way to a regional title and winning their three games by a combined score of 31-2 — I'd still say OU is more impressive because UCLA managed to completely avoid Arizona State, the No. 2 seed in its regional — the Bruins should have everyone's attention.

Watch out for sluggers Megan Grant and Jordan Woolery. Each blasted two homers in the regional with Grant driving in six runs and Woolery plating seven.

# Playing flag football in Olympics 'a dream' for Jefferson

The NFL unanimously voted to allow its players to participate in flag football at the 2028 Los Angeles Summer Olympics.

Minnesota Vikings wide receiver Justin Jefferson is among many who are excited about the league's decision.

"Just to think about the chances of playing in the Olympics and getting a gold medal, it's a dream," Jefferson told reporters following the announcement May 20 at the NFL's spring meeting in Minneapolis.

Jefferson was named one of the NFL's global flag football ambassadors in

2023. He has since worked with the league to raise the fast-growing sport's profile.

Even so, the 25-year-old never expected the work to so quickly lead to a potential opportunity to compete in the Olympics.

"Just reverting back to being a kid and watching the track and field meets, watching basketball win the gold medal — that's something that as a kid, I always wanted to be a part of," Jefferson said. "But football wasn't (global). So now that we're expanding the game and we're going more globally, it's pretty cool."

While Jefferson is interested in potentially participating in the 2028

Olympics, he noted he would take time to weigh his decision to play.

"I definitely would look forward to it if it came down to it, but that's something I have to ask myself," Jefferson said of participating in the Olympics, per ESPN's Brooke Pryor.

Jefferson isn't the only NFL player considering participating in the Olympics. Patrick Mahomes and Tyreek Hill are among the most notable players to express an interest.

Like Jefferson, those athletes figure to take time to contemplate their decisions, but the NFL's ruling has at least cleared a path for those stars to compete for spots on the Olympic team if they so desire.

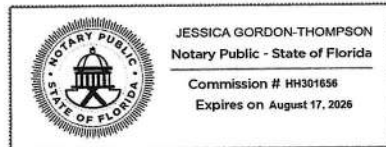


